

BIBLE QUIZ STAFF INSTRUCTIONS

TALLY KEEPER

Score Sheets

- receive “score sheets” from scorekeepers **after multiple choice quizzing in each level**
- add all multiple choice scores for each individual clubber
- add all speed quizzing scores to appropriate score sheets as they complete events (**15 point bonus** given to clubbers with **3 correct answers** in the Speed Quizzing)
- add multiple choice, and speed quizzing scores together for each clubber
- add quizzers’ scores together to get team score
- using “Individual High Score Worksheet” NOTE clubber with highest and clubber with second highest score in each level (as well as any ties in those highest scores.)

Team Awards (highest possible team score: 390 points)

- Determine (by highest score) which team is first, second, etc
- Write team placement on top of each score sheet (fourth and highest only please).
- **Ties:** all team ties must be broken. Please note all ties on a Post It note, and communicate these to Quiz Master as soon as possible. One speed question will be asked of all teams involved. The first one to answer the question right will receive the highest placing, the other team will take the placing immediately following that.
- For each level of quizzing (ie Book 1, 2, 3, 4 - note grade levels in each book also) stack score sheets in pile as follows :

fourth place team
third place team
second place team
first place team
all other placements

Place each level into a paperclip and give to Quiz Master when requested (lowest age level on the top, please.)

Individual Awards

- **Quiz Champion** – must achieve perfect score of 140 points
 - **Ties:** can only be broken if quizzers are from same BOOK & AGE level. Ties are broken by asking one speed quiz question. The clubber with the right answer becomes the quiz champion, the other clubber becomes the “highest honor” quizzers for their specific book/age level.
 - may be one from each level
 - Cannot be awarded to “Highest Honor” winner
- **Highest Honor** – highest individual score of **all clubbers in one level** (ie: Book 1/grade 3/4)
 - **Ties** – must be broken with one speed quiz question
 - Cannot be awarded to “Quiz Champion”
 - **ribbon** given only if more than 100 points.
 - **Will be recognized no matter the point value**

SPEED QUIZ TALLY: using Tally form

After each question is answered, Quiz Master will ask clubber’s name and church name. Please print these legibly in appropriate spaces. Score correct answer/incorrect answer using points listed on form. Communicate to Quiz Master when a clubber quizzes out or answers two questions incorrectly. Give scoresheet to Tally Keeper after final question. Do NOT add scores!

BIBLE QUIZ STAFF INSTRUCTIONS

SCORE KEEPER

One score sheet for each team. You should have no more than one sheet for each age level of quizzing. Try not to score your home church's quizzers.

Arrange quizzers on stage. When quizzers of one age group are seated-go and find the team on your score sheet. **Quizzers must sit in order listed on score sheet.**

Watch your 3 quizzers only.

Print your name on each score sheet please!

Multiple Choice Quizzing

Watch for:

- **Eyes on own paddle**
- **Paddles must be raised** immediately following Quiz Master's "paddles up."
- **Paddles may not be exchanged** after "paddles up" is called
- **Absolutely no talking** between quizzers.

Warnings:

- If a clubber breaks any of the above rules: **go and speak with quizzer**
warn them that next infraction will disqualify the points for that question

Recording:

- record quizzers' answers: **A – B – C** in column provided
- When Quiz Master tells the answer, write answer in next column
- give **10 points for each correct answer**
- **DO NOT ADD POINTS UP.**

At end of Multiple Choice, hand score sheet to Tally Keeper

Speed Quizzing (if you are asked to do so at meet)

Arrange quizzers on stage in same order as score sheet.

Write down paddle number on score sheet (button should be same as sign # on quizzers)

Points:

- **15 points for each correct answer**
- **– 5 points for each incorrect answer**
- **15 points** for three correct answers in speed quizzing (does not have to be consecutive questions). Please write this in the "**Bonus Points**" space.

Watch For: (Quiz Master and judges will deem whether an answer is correct or not.)

- **2 incorrect answers from one quizzer** – record score, and tell Quiz Master. Go to quizzer and ask them to set their button on the floor.
- **3 correct answers from one quizzer** – record score, and tell Quiz Master about the quiz out. Go to quizzer and ask them to set their button on the floor.

After each level of Speed Quizzing, turn that score sheet into Tally Keeper table.
