- Camper Eligibility:
 - Priority will be given to British Columbia clubbers.
 - First time campers: must have completed at least two
Awana handbooks (grade 3-grade 12 age appropriate material*.)
 - Returning Campers, must have completed age appropriate handbook(s)*
since the last time they attended Scholarship Camp.
*One main study & one elective for high school campers.
 - 11 years of age by 1st day of camp and entering grade six through graduation
- Cost: \$ 65.00 registration fee (NON REFUNDABLE)

 - Camp Fees: \$290.00 at time of application.
