

FUNDRAISING IDEAS

Awana GO (global outreach) equips leaders to connect kids and adults to God's heart for the world and invites you to partner with Awana for greater Kingdom impact as you carry out your Great Commission vision. Awana GO is a great way to mobilize your kids, youth and entire congregation to put their faith into action.



1. Set the date and get it on your Awana calendar
2. Set up a fundraising goal for your club. Set a goal that will stretch your faith and trust God to help you achieve it. Track funds as they come in. (a thermometer works)
3. Print some posters in a bigger size at your local print shop to promote the Campaign in your church.

SOME FUNDRAISING IDEAS TO GET YOU STARTED!

- Have a theme night
- Plan a fundraising dinner and make an authentic Mongolian meal. Set a suggested donation amount and invite parents if you are meeting in person and that works for your group. Alternatively, families could plan to make the meal together at home or with a small group –search the web for Mongolian meal ideas!
- Do you know someone who would love to match every dollar brought in? Perhaps your church could match dollar for dollar from the Missions budget.
- Place the GO Stickers on a bucket and when kids go shopping at the Awana store, give them the opportunity to donate to the GO project rather than buying something for themselves. This helps them to think of others!
- Have an Awana GO Sunday and include the whole congregation in hearing about Mongolia and why you are raising funds. Use the About the Campaign and the Information Sheet. found on the website. Invite them to participate by taking up a free-will offering at the end.
- Have a competition between the boys and girls with two separate GO containers to collect coins/dollars! Celebrate with a pizza night!
- A verse-a-thon is always a great way to raise funds with a dual purpose of kids learning verses and hiding them in their heart! If you are meeting virtually, your field team may be able to help you set this up.

On that note... Have you ever wondered how you could run a church-wide, multi-generational, program in your church? Last year some Awana churches in Canada did just that by organizing a church-wide Verse-a-thon! We were so inspired by their success story, that we connected with them to see if what they did could be replicated in other churches!

This church-wide, multi-generational verse-a-thon could include seniors' groups, past Awana leaders, Awana alumni, parents, and grandparents! ALL were welcome to participate.
